As a result of our changing countries and preparing to go to Madagascar, this has brought a change to our plans for when we arrive in Africa. Instead of heading directly to Madagascar, we will now be heading first to Albertville, France. We will be attending nine months of Language School to learn and become fluent in the French language. Please pray for us during this important time that we will learn the language quickly & proficiently. Also, please pray for the girls as they will be transitioning from being home schooled to going to a regular school during our time in France.

PREPARING TO LEAVE!

One of the realities of preparing to move to another country and especially moving to Africa is the time it takes to get ready to do that. I thought I would share a few of those preparations.

1. We recently applied for and received passports for Carey and the girls. We are also preparing to make application for our student visas for our time in France.
2. We just recently took our first series of three trips to go for vaccinations and immunizations. Carey has to get the most with a total of 9 shots. Our girls don't like needles! (but what kids do?)
3. We are deciding on what to pack for France, what to pack for Africa, what to store at home and what needs to be thrown out. After over 13 years of marriage, that is a lot of stuff to go through!

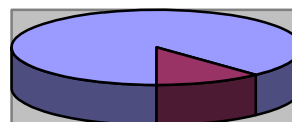


PRAYER REQUESTS
